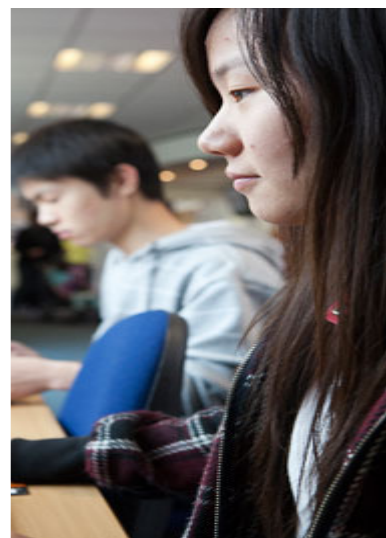
Their students have achieved a pass rate of 99% in A level exams and 100% in the [International Baccalaureate](#).

Entry Requirements

Their entry requirements depend on what level you want to study at.



English and IELTS

To join their English Language Programmes they need to know your level of English.

When you complete your application form, please provide evidence of your English ability (IELTS, TOEFL, High School examination).

You must be 16 years or more when you start the course.

Pre-University

International Foundation Programme (IFP)

Foundation programmes are designed for students who have completed a High School education in their home country.

To join their International Foundation Programme you must:

- Be aged 17 years or over at the start of the course.
- Speak and understand English to a good level and have a minimum IELTS score of 5.0. Or equivalent English level qualification.
- Have a High School qualification.

Higher Education Foundation Programme (HEFP)

The HEFP is designed for students who want to take a Bachelor Degree (BA, BSc, LLB or BEng/MEng) in the UK, often for a course with competitive

entry grades.

You may have a school leaving qualification that is not always recognised for direct entry to degree courses.

You will need a minimum of IELTS 5.5 to join the HEFP programme.

Petrochemical Engineering Foundation

To join the Petrochemical Engineering Foundation you must have achieved good grades in your High School or College exams.

You will also need IELTS 5.0 or an equivalent English qualification.

A Levels

For A Level courses a satisfactory school record is required. You will need to have 4 - 6 passes in your secondary school exams including maths, plus an English level minimum of IELTS 5.0 or equivalent.

Summer School

Paying your Fees

A deposit of £1000 is required before we can send you an acceptance letter.

The total balance is payable on the day you enrol.

£175 per week
Fees must be paid before the start of the course.

Accommodation

Homestay

Staying with a local family
This includes breakfast and evening meal, plus lunch at weekends.

Homestay Self Catering

Bills are included but not the telephone bill.

Halls of Residence



In halls you can prepare your own meals or have your meals at the College restaurant. Halls are popular, so try to book early.
